FRESH WIND	1. Sports Club.	We have created a sports group focused on training young people not only in the sports area, but we are committed to comprehensive training in the spiritual and professional area and thus avoid recruiting young people into gangs in the vulnerable neighborhoods of the sector. We have delivered around 250 supplies of uniforms for the sports team.	1,100 boys and girls have been part of this program	Niquitao neighborhood, Medellín.
	2. Educational Support.	We support young people who have finished their academic cycle of secondary school and manage vocational training in higher education for them, understanding that not everyone can be a professional soccer player. WOMAN TALENT	1. Training Program	Talented Woman trains women and men in vulnerable conditions, sex workers, street vendors. We train them in the clothing industry, as operators in flat machines, filleting machines, coating machines. Conquering territories is another massive event that focuses on women at risk in the municipalities of Antioquia, where we work on the issue of identity. With the money collected we finance social works of the Christian Community of Faith.
